- Electronic Classer's Software ensures current NWD is used
- Growers provide information required by buyers, processors, manufacturers & retailers
- Strong support for NWD & its Integrity Program (NWD-IP) by wool trade
- NWD forms basis of animal welfare requirements for Australian & International Integrity Schemes
- Next NWD Review to commence 2023

#### Main reasons for Non Compliance:

- Grower:
  - Signed incorrect declaration made by Classer/other
  - made incorrect declaration \_
  - unable to obtain evidence of AA for purchased sheep
  - did not respond to request for evidence of AA

#### **Outcomes from AA Verifications:**

- Exporters & Brokers advised of Non Compliance for each Brand/Lot
- Non Compliant Brands are recalled when wool offered for sale in the future

#### **Improvement to Compliance:**

- Greater grower awareness of NWD
- NWDs with two CM questions & circling mob Mulesing Status

### Main reasons for Non Compliance:

- Grower:
  - Signed incorrect declaration made by Classer/other
  - Made incorrect declaration on homebred or purchased mob(s)

### **Outcomes from NM/CM Inspections:**

- Exporters & Brokers advised of Non Compliance for each Brand/Lot
- Non Compliant Brands recalled when wool offered for sale in the future

### **Improvement to Compliance:**

- Greater grower awareness of NWD
- NWDs with two CM questions & circling mob Mulesing Status



- Exporters request AWEX Mulesing Status Certificates for their clients with specific Mulesing Status requirements
- Consignments range in size from 2 bales to 750 bales
- AWEX validates Brands/Lots against Desk Audits, NM/CM Inspections, AA Verifications & previous declaration history
- Exporters remove Non Compliant Brands (Lots) from consignments either in-store in Australia or at the mill
- Exporters may make claims against Growers/Brokers for incorrect declarations
