CHRIS RAN LIN Fashion Designer

Born in China, Chris Ran Lin grew up surrounded by fashion: his mother was a dressmaker and his grandmother had expertise in the artistry of traditional Chinese craft. At 18 years old, Ran Lin immigrated to Melbourne, Australia where he studied fashion design at RMIT University. In 2013, the graduate launched his namesake menswear label in Melbourne with the unlimited potential of the knitted wool garment at its core. In 2016 and 2017, Chris Ran Lin was a regional finalist in the International Woolmark Prize representing Australia and New Zealand.
